What is JSPS?

Japan Society for the Promotion of Science

- Established in 1932
 - through an endowment by Emperor Showa.
- Japan's core funding agency
- The entire spectrum of academic fields



Rooster:

Harbinger of new knowledge that promises a brilliant future for humankind.



JSPS: A Funding Agency for "Science"

JSPS funds:

- Researches
 - Grants-in-Aid, "KAKENHI": \$2 Billion /80,000 projects for researchers at Japanese Institutions, regardless of their nationality
- Fellowships
 - for 6,000 pre-/post-docs
- Mobility
 - from pre-docs to professors, 10,000 researchers
- International Collaborations
 - -Bi- and Multi- lateral

JSPS selects through:

- Bottom-up approach: invite applications through open calls
- Competitive funding: conduct evaluations via peer review
- Fair and transparent screening:

Make selections based on academic merit
