JSPS Summer Program provides opportunities for young pre- and post-doctoral researchers from North America and Europe to receive an orientation on Japanese culture and research systems and to pursue research under the guidance of host researchers at a Japanese university or research institute over a period of two months during the summer.

June 16 – August 18, 2021: After arriving in Japan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Research experience at host institutions</li><li>■ Homestay program on weekend (optional)</li><li>■ Online events to foster friendship and form networks (TBD)</li></ul>
